The value of the bursary is **£1000** and applicants are requested to send a CV and complete the attached form, which includes writing a short statement indicating how such a bursary would be used. A short reference from a student's current tutor may also be required. The deadline for applications is **5pm on Friday April 1, 2016** and the bursary must be used by **December 31, 2016**. The 'performing arts' shall comprise music (all genres), drama (acting, directing, producing) and dance. The 'applicant'/'recipient' shall be one person, though she/he may work in collaboration with others directly related to the project, who shall also be named on the application form.

EdmissionUK reserve the right to request evidence of expenses in accordance with conditions attached to this bursary. The sum of £1000.00 (One Thousand Pounds) is the maximum amount offered by EdmissionUK, and recipients are responsible for meeting any additional costs in excess of this amount. The amount may not be split between multiple projects. If the proposed project does not go ahead as set out in the application form (e.g. because of a lack of other funding elsewhere) then the recipient will be expected to return the bursary in full, unless otherwise agreed in writing at the time of receipt.

Results will be announced via email on Monday April 4, 2016. EdmissionUK reserve the right not to award any grants if they deem that no suitable applications are received. The decision of the EdmissionUK adjudication panel will be final.

If awarded this bursary, you agree to mention the support of EdmissionUK in any recordings, concerts, exhibitions, and publication/s (or similar) that directly result from this bursary. You also agree to write a short report for inclusion on the EdmissionUK website.
